Requirements for Private Swimming Pools

Building and Board of Health

Any structure that contains water over 24 inches (610mm) in depth requires a Building and Board of Health permit as well as Conservation Commission approval.

Applications require;

- 1. A plot plan showing location of pool and any other buildings on lot, also showing how it will be fenced.
- 2. Pool wall must be at least 6ft from rear and side lot lines, and can't be located in front yard setback area (25 FT).
- 3. Approval must be granted from the Board of Health and the Conservation Commission.
- 4. Electrical Permit must be applied for at the same time as the pool application is submitted.
- 5. Complete plans of pool construction and filtering system must be submitted.
- 6. All pools must have a fence and gate at least 6FT high (Town of Hull bylaw) surrounding the property or pool area. All gates must be self latching

ALL Requirements are listed on the Board of Health and Building Department Application.
