



Amendment 1. Weir River Estuary Proposed Walking and Bicycling Route

Amendment 2 Weir River Estuary Park Access Policy

1. It is the intention of the Weir River Estuary Park to **conserve and restore land and water as wildlife habitat.**
2. **Educational and recreational access** will be provided in ways that have **minimal impact on habitat.**
3. Specifically,
 - a) Use the **water as a path.**
 - b) Provide **access to the water in such a way as to protect existing and potential native habitat.**
 - c) Enforce the **no wake zone**, which includes the entire estuary.
 - d) Use **existing roadways as bicycle and pedestrian paths.**
 - e) Make roadways **bicycle-and-pedestrian-friendly.**
 - f) Install **educational signage** for bicyclists and pedestrians along existing roadways.
 - g) Provide **foot paths connected to the Estuary Center for public use.**
 - h) **Elsewhere, limit foot paths to neighborhood and educational use.**
 - i) **Prohibit motor bikes and vehicles off-road.**
 - j) Keep **parking minimal** within the Park area.
 - k) Limit parking to **existing pavement.**
 - l) **Encourage and utilize a public transit** access network.
 - m) Recognizing that roadways can affect water,
 - 1) **Improve water flow quantity across road rights-of-way** to protect existing and potential habitats.
 - 2) **Protect water quality from road storm-water run-off** to ensure healthy habitats for wildlife [see habitat map].
