ARTICLE I

Elections and Appointments

S42-1. Definitions.

As used in this Article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICE - Any office established by statute and filled by a town election, excluding town committees and other partisan elected positions.

S42-2. Limitations on holding municipal office.

No person shall hold more than one (1) elected municipal office simultaneously on or after January 31, 1983. If a person holding a municipal office is elected or appointed to a second elected municipal office, the first office shall automatically become vacant as soon as the person is sworn in to the second office. If such person is not sworn in within ten (10) days following election or appointment, the second office shall automatically become vacant.

ARTICLE II

Physical Exam

S42-3. Certification of fitness required.

Every applicant for permanent appointive employment by the town shall be certified by a practicing physician designated by the Selectmen, or to his or her physical fitness to perform the duties of the position to which such applicant seeks appointment. Any

applicant for temporary appointive employment by the town who is to be employed for thirty (30) days or more or any temporary appointive employee who has been employed by the town for thirty (30) days and has not been so certified, shall be certified by a physician designated by the Selectmen, as to his or her physical fitness to do the work required by the town. The certification required hereunder shall be in such form as the Selectmen shall determine.

ARTICLE III
Town Treasurer-Town Collector

S42-4. Combination of positions authorized; election.

The town authorizes the Town Treasurer to act as the Town Collector after the 1979 Annual Town Election, and the Town Clerk shall place on the ballot for the 1979 Annual Town election the combined position of Town Treasurer-Town Collector, to be elected for a term of three (3) years, in accordance with the provisions of MGL C. 41, s1.

Note: This position became appointed according to Chapter 8 of the Acts of 1989 so called Town Manager form of Governemnt.
