## 2012-2013 State Income Eligibility Table and Tuition Formula

### for Full-Day Kindergarten Programs in Districts with Quality Full-Day Kindergarten Grants

Determining family eligibility for reduced tuition: First, calculate a family's gross monthly income (to convert monthly income from weekly income, multiply by 4.33; to calculate monthly income from bi-weekly income, multiply by 2.17). Next, find the column with the family's size written at the top. Read down the column until you come to the correct monthly income, then read across to Columns C and D to determine a family's first and second payment and annual tuition.
