

## **Sustainable Transportation Committee**

March 19, 2007 minutes

We discussed the **Metropolitan Planning Organization “Journey to 2030” transportation plan.**

Patrick attended the public review session in Dedham. Judeth and possibly other Committee members will attend session in Hingham.

- Appendix A, Arterial, includes four Chapter 90 projects for Hull:
  1. DM0181 Manomet Ave., \$850,000
  2. DM0182 Samoset Ave., \$900,000
  3. 601607 Atlantic Ave., \$985,000, Design status: Pre-25%
  4. 601608 Fitzpatrick Way, \$250,000, Design status: Pre-25%
- See p. 123 of the plan for ratings of these projects
- Note the amount of funds included for many Bicycle/Pedestrian projects on the North Shore.
- Judeth will draft a comment letter to submit at the Wednesday MPO public review presentation. Letter will include:
  1. Keep boats running.
  2. Provide bike access at train stations.
  3. Save trees along Route 3.
  4. Construct the permanent Fore River Bridge.
  5. Adopt a policy of making bike lanes along all major roads, except limited-access highways.

The **Sate Bicycle Plan** is nearing completion, but here is still time to submit Hull and South Shore bicycle routes to the State plan.

We talked about a response to Chief Billings' letter re **Bicycling and Walking Plan**. Draft sent separately. Judeth will check on State Bike Plan Update deadline.

We discussed the **trolley demonstration** proposed in the application to EPA for a Zero-Emissions Transportation Improvement Plan. Patrick suggested a summer weekend trolley, advertised on local cable TV stations.
