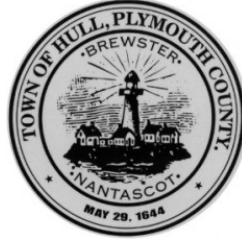

SPRING 2018 STREET SWEEPER SCHEDULE TO BE RESUMED

The Town of Hull Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that on Monday June 4th, we will resume our annual street sweeping program. Because of the larger than normal volume of sand on the roads, the sweeper will be concentrating on main roads and in environmentally sensitive areas as well as the area's most impacted by this winters weather.

Once these areas have been completed, the sweeper will be focusing on neighborhood areas and secondary roads.

The streets in the Village and in Allerton Hill were swept before our machine broke down so we will resume the program starting at XYZ Street and head south from there. Once the rest of the town is completed, we will return and re-sweep the Village and Allerton Hill areas.

Tentative Schedule (may have to be modified due to weather or other unforeseen issues):

Week of June 4-8:	A Street to XYZ Streets
Week of June 11-15:	Kenberma section to A Street
Week of June 18-22:	Sunset Point area to Kenberma
Week of June 25-29:	Rockaway section to Bay Street neighborhood
Week of July 9-13:	West Corner / Atlantic Ave neighborhood
Week of July 16-20:	Village neighborhoods
Week of July 23-27:	Allerton Hill

The Department of Public Works reminds residents that street sweeping is done for safety reasons and is also an important component of the "Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping in Municipal Operations" portion of the Town's Stormwater Management Plan.
