**This certification was conferred by the Board of Certification of the state–wide organization of the local Tax Collectors and Treasurers, the Massachusetts Collectors and Treasurers Association. Certification is awarded only after candidates have been in office a minimum of three years and complete a rigorous schedule of required courses. The Association’s annual school is held at UMass Amherst in August of each year and all candidates for Certification must attend a minimum of three years. Lastly, they must successfully pass their Certification Board’s examination, covering such subjects as municipal finance law, property and motor vehicle tax laws and collection, cash management and numerous other subjects, which are of concern to public finance officials.**
