I hope to have a successful year providing lunch to all of your children here in Hull. - Students can prepay for their lunches with a check made out to the Hull Food Service Program and presenting it to any of the cashiers. These checks can be made out in any amount and will allow your child to move through the line without having to exchange cash.
- Some students had balances remaining on their accounts from June of last year. If your prepayment doesn't seem to be lasting as long as it should this is most likely the reason.
- As many of you have seen, the lunch prices have gone up by \$.50 this year. Lunch at the Jacobs School now costs \$2.50 and \$2.75 at both the Memorial Middle School and the High School.
- Chicken Patties and Grilled Cheese sandwiches will be available daily at the Jacobs School in addition to the main lunch choice. This option allows students to still purchase a meal if they don't like the first menu choice and is available with the daily fruit and vegetable offerings.
