Town Manager Update:

The Select Board will be signing off on the Town Warrant an Wed. March 23 at 8:00am

The town budget review continued:

The Library budget was presented by Diane Costagliola with the following highlights:

- Ongoing physical plant repairs include modification of layout to the childrens room and future second floor renovations to move the library further along expanded digital services.
- The current heating system is both an oil fired and gas fired boiler system for different parts of the Building. A plan is being developed to consolidate to one gas fired system
- Ms. Costagliola explained the mix of state aid and town funding:
 - 1. The state requires 40 hours of minimum operation over 5 days per week which we meet.
 - 2. The book budget must be population based. Our assessment is \$56,000 of which we have only \$42,000. We make up the difference with funds from the Friends of the Library and use of the \$14,000 that the state grants our library.
 - 3. Friends of the Library fund 12 passes for museums and such, childrens summer programs and part of the 4000 ebook collection
