The Board of Assessors continued to meet monthly over the past quarter. The board reviewed and acted upon several abatement applications and met with taxpayers who wished to discuss their individual tax abatement applications. The board also provided administrative oversight by reviewing and acting upon Assessor's office expenditures over the past month. Tax payer applications for personal exemptions were reviewed, discussed and acted upon accordingly. Personal exemptions are available to qualifying elderly, veteran and legally blind taxpayers.

The Board was reorganized in light of the recent election. Two Board members, Mario Grieco and Pamela Sinton-Coffman were re-elected to office in the May election. The Board unanimously voted to keep Nazzareno DiVito as Chairman of the Board.

The Hull Board of Assessor is studying a unique parcel of land with a lighthouse that was recently sold. This property was once a part of Hull and then owned by the government. Today this privately owner lighthouse may be under the jurisdiction of Hull for tax purposes.
