## TOWN BOARD Quarterly REPORT December 21, 2017

#### Goals / Mission

The Historic District Commission [HDC] reviews alterations to buildings, structures and sites in Hull Village, National Register Fort Revere and the Cemetery as a Chapter 40C Massachusetts local historic district, established in 1994.

### **Current Initiatives / Progress**

Current application under review:

- 48 Highland Ave. window replacement, retaining wall, etc.
- 1 Main Street demo existing, new house on pilings for V Flood Zone; also ZBA & ConCom Projects anticipated in the near future:
  - Outreach to local realtors for awareness of the district
  - First Town Hall / Village Fire Station restoration
  - · Restoration efforts at Fort Revere including tower

#### **Recent Projects Reviewed / Certificates Issued:**

- Public Hearings & Certificates issued: 29 Main Street new house; 58 Vautrinot extensive renovations; 51 Main Street garage addition
- Reviewed: 58 Highland replacement windows; 30 Andrew rear deck; 14 Gallops Hill Rd. porch posts and rail; 42 Western rear deck; 48 Vautrinot trim & siding
- The Officer Quarters building at Fort Revere reviewed for the DCR's ongoing restoration being in conjunction with the Hull Historical Commission [HHC].
- HDC worked closely with the architect, contractor and town building department for the recently completed exterior restoration of the Public Library / John Boyle O'Reilly House to ensure accurate historic restoration of the 1889 Shingle Style building.
