**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR GRANT OF LOCATION OF GAS MAINS
AND RELATED MATTERS**

Notice is hereby given that National Grid is requesting consent for the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways and places of the **Town of Hull** and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

780 feet of 6-inch, bare steel (1931/1942) and approximately 35 feet of 4-inch, bare steel (1931) with approximately 815 feet of 6-inch, plastic in Eastman Rd from the existing 6-inch, plastic at Nantasket Av to the end of main at the pump house

Abutters in particular to the project area in which National Grid proposes to transmit and distribute gas, locate the gas mains and perform related work and the work described herein, and members of the public in general, are notified that National Grid has requested that the Hull Board of Selectman consent to the location of the proposed gas mains and related work, and that the Board of Selectman will have a **Remote Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 2, 2022 at 7:30 p.m.**, to review and act on this request. The public is invited to attend and participate in said hearing. **The remote meeting information is as follows:**
