

PUBLIC SAFETY KEY BOX

Section 71-7.1. Public Safety Key Box

When access to or within a structure or an area is unduly difficult due to secured openings, or where immediate access is necessary for life-saving or firefighting purposes, the Fire Chief may require a key box installed in an accessible location. The keybox shall be approved by the Fire Chief or his designee and shall contain keys and such paperwork and information as required by the Fire Department. The key box shall be used by the Fire Department solely for the purposes stated. This section shall also apply to all Class One and Class Two Fire Alarm Systems.
