

# ATLANTIC AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE May 15, 2023

## Previous Two Weeks Summary

In the previous two weeks, the Contractor has begun the full depth roadway excavation between 900 ft. east of Gunrock Avenue and the eastern project limits at the Cohasset Town Line which is the third and final phase of the full depth reconstruction.

## Two Week Look Ahead

The Contractor will continue excavating the roadway between 900 ft. east of Gunrock Avenue and the Cohasset Town this week. The existing asphalt pavement will be removed, and Atlantic Avenue will have a gravel surface for most of this week while the Contractor places new gravel and re-grades the roadway. Paving is scheduled for Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup> to Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup> and Monday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> to Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> in this area, as well as on South Avenue and Atlantic House Road.

Granite curb installation between Meade Avenue and 900 feet east of Gunrock Avenue will commence on Monday, May 22<sup>nd</sup> which will be followed by the construction of the new sidewalks and driveways in this area. Curbing crews will start across from Meade Avenue and progress eastward throughout the next two weeks.

Any driveways that have decorative surfaces (cobblestones, pavers, sea-shells, etc.) that are impacted by the roadway work will be temporarily stored until the Contractor is ready to re-install them.

### **Traffic Impacts**

Expect through vehicle traffic to be detoured between School Street and Jerusalem Road during the daytime for the foreseeable future with one lane of traffic open for local traffic. Pedestrians, bicycles, school buses, and emergency vehicles will continue to be able to travel through the construction area. Access to residences, businesses and the Town Hall will also be maintained. At least one travel lane will be maintained at all times with police directing traffic as needed.

Please exercise caution traveling through Atlantic Avenue and seek alternate routes when possible. The construction may cause noise disruption during the work hours of 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
