

# ATLANTIC AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE

Monday June 12, 2023

## **Previous Two Weeks Summary**

In the previous two weeks, the Contractor has been installing the granite curbing between Richards Road and 900 feet east of Gunrock Avenue, as well working to raise manhole covers to grade.

### Two Week Look Ahead

The Contractor will be working throughout the entirety of Atlantic Avenue over the next few weeks with several different construction operations. This includes:

- Wednesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>: Paving sidewalks and driveways for the stretch of Atlantic Avenue between Nantasket Avenue and 900 feet east of Gunrock Avenue.
- Week of June 19<sup>th</sup>: Granite curb installation will resume between Stony Beach Roach and the Cohasset Town line.
- Beginning on June 20<sup>th</sup>: New steel guardrail installation along Straits Pond will begin. In addition, fence work will commence with the removal of any fences throughout Atlantic Avenue that are required to be relocated due to the roadway work.

Any driveways that have decorative surfaces (cobblestones, pavers, sea-shells, etc.) that are impacted by the roadway work will be temporarily stored until the Contractor is ready to re-install them.

#### **Traffic Impacts**

Expect through vehicle traffic to be detoured between School Street and Jerusalem Road during the daytime for the foreseeable future with one lane of traffic open for local traffic. Pedestrians, bicycles, school buses, and emergency vehicles will continue to be able to travel through the construction area. Access to residences, businesses and the Town Hall will also be maintained. At least one travel lane will be maintained at all times with police directing traffic as needed.

Please exercise caution traveling through Atlantic Avenue and seek alternate routes when possible. The construction may cause noise disruption during the work hours of 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
