<u>Tennis backboard</u>: Smyth presents his idea for a backboard at the N St courts. After deliberation by the Commission the motion led by Grey at this time is: Due to the location, cost and targeted use of this backboard to deny Smyths request. Motion by Grey, second by Whelan, unanimous vote. 5-0

<u>Outdoor basketball courts:</u> Sestito presents an argument for opening the outdoor basketball courts. He indicates he is not representing Hull Youth basketball, rather a parent involved in the activity. He asks that the basketball courts be open for use by the children in the community. Grey suggests opening the courts at Greenhill and Village locations would be best because they can be locked and managed. Twombly suggests opening the courts up with the only restriction being Covid-19 guidelines be followed. Leary agrees with Twombly noting the state mask mandate in place. Dunn and Whelan both concur. Twombly makes a motion to open the outdoor basketball courts with the appropriate signage (\$450 cost) making all aware of the guidelines in place for court use. In his motion, he states if the protocols are not followed the courts will be closed for future use. Second by Leary, unanimous vote-5-0

Kenberma Project: Grey updates on progress. The Town is currently waiting for paving operations to reopen to lay the topcoat on the courts. This will likely happen in mid-April.

<u>Recreation Director Position:</u> Discussion regarding the needs of a Recreation Director. Sub committee formed, Leary and Twombly will report back to the Commission February 8th with a job description and plan.
