Rebuilding Nantasket Avenue at Surfside Resumes

The rebuilding of Nantasket Avenue from Water St. to Anastos Corner in the “Surfside” neighborhood will re-start on or about April 7, 2014. The project is being funded by a grant from the EOHED’s MassWorks program. The HRA is providing funding for project engineering and the Town of Hull is providing project management. The contractor, P.A. Landers will provide notices to businesses and residents that will be affected by their work. Additionally the project engineer, CHA, will provide weekly updates and schedule of work on its Facebook page. The project was initiated last fall and will be completed in the spring of 2015. Work will only be conducted in the spring and fall seasons to limit impacts to summer business and commuters. However, with this type of work some impacts to traffic and parking should be anticipated. Work this spring includes completion of the drainage system, pulverizing the road and laying the new base and binder layer of paving. This spring’s work will be completed by May 29th. During construction the contractors will always keep one travel lane open. The contractor changed plans and they will prohibit all parking in their work area on both sides of the street. However, they will work in a limited area which will move from the Water St. intersection towards Anastos Corner. When they are complete in one area they will open that area for parking. Parking will be available to the north or south side of the work area.
