## **Advanced Placement (AP) Exams**


#### **Overview**

- AP Exam: Standards-based exams that are given throughout the world.
- In order to label a class "AP," the syllabus must be submitted and approved by The College Board.
- Many colleges waive classes for students who earn a 3 or higher on an AP exam.
- These are college-level courses.
- The highest possible score is 5.




## Number of Students Taking AP Exams (2012 – 2016)




## Percentage of Students Taking at least one AP Exam (2012 – 2016)




## Number of AP Exams Taken (2012 – 2016)

## **AP Trends**


- We continue to increase the number of students enrolled in AP courses.
- We continue to see a rise in AP scores.
- The waiver system has increased opportunities for students to take AP courses and has not led to lower AP test scores.

## Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)

## **Overview**


- Nationally normed and standardized test
- Tests student's basic knowledge and skills in the areas of reading, mathematics and writing
- Evaluates how a student thinks, reasons and communicates
- SAT scores are still an essential part of the admissions process.
- Maximum possible score: 2400 (800 each in critical reading, mathematics and writing)
- The New SAT was introduced last spring:
  - Writing portion optional
  - More relevant vocabulary
  - No more penalty for guessing

## **SAT Trends**

- These scores are for members of the Class of 2016 who took the "old" SAT.
- The College Board is not releasing average scores for the "new" SAT until next year.
- Our scores are up this year. The pattern is best described as "up and down."
- Our goal is to have HHS students score at or above the Massachusetts state average.
- We are above the national average in all areas.
