

## **ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT**

It is the belief of the School Committee that any student who is capable of, and wishes to do, college-level work while in high school should be permitted to do so and shall be given assistance in enrolling advanced courses.

Any 11th or 12th grade student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by his/her counselor may enroll in a course at an approved college for college credit, at no cost to the Hull Public Schools. (Students not in 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade may enroll with the approval of the school principal after consultation with his/her guidance counselor.) If the student wishes to receive high school credit for the course, he/she must request permission from his/her principal, through the counselor, to apply the course toward high school graduation requirements.
