Setting up the Internship

- Students initially meet with their guidance counselor.
- Available period is identified.
- Areas of interest are identified.
- Potential internships are explored.

Intern Work Week

- Student interns work Monday through Friday.
- Assignments turned into Mr. Donohue:
 - Weekly Time Sheets
 - Written reflection on experience 2 times per term
- Mr. Donohue and/or Mr. Quatromoni have contact with internship partners as needed.
