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SCHOLARSHIPS

The Hull School Committee, recognizing the importance of a post graduate education, welcomes contributions from the community in support of the scholarship program and encourages the administration to develop and implement activities that will increase the amount of scholarship funds.

<u>Governance</u> The School Committee and the Superintendent will be responsible for establishing policies and procedures regulating the scholarship program. All scholarship donations to be presented to students must first be approved by the School Committee.

<u>Equal Opportunity</u> Scholarships will be accepted by the School Committee provided they meet acceptance standards and do not discriminate against any student because of Race, Creed, Color, National Origin, Religion, or Sex.

<u>Standards</u> The Superintendent and High School Principal with the assistance of the High School Faculty shall develop written standards, criteria, and procedures for awarding scholarships.

<u>Faculty Selection Committee</u> A committee representing the High School Professional Staff will be appointed by the High School Principal and assigned the responsibility of determining recipients in accordance with established criteria.

General Scholarship Fund Scholarship contributions which are not designated by the donor as an individual scholarship will be deposited in the General Scholarship Fund. The interest obtained from investing these funds will be awarded as scholarships.

<u>Advisory Committees</u> The School Committee and Administration will encourage participation by the community in committees designed to formulate and to implement fund raising activities and to recommend the most beneficial programs for investing funds. The Advisory Committees will be appointed by the School Committee.

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
