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COMMUNICATIONS WITH PARENTS

The School Committee recognizes the fact that parents and guardians play an integral part in the success or failure of the Hull Public Schools to educate the children. The Committee, therefore, emphasizes the need, on the part of the staff, to maintain strong lines of communication with the parents and guardians of each child. Communication lines are developed in many ways – telephone calls, notes, formal notices, conferences – and the staff should attempt to use all of them in its quest to maintain a strong home/school relationship.
