RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

We believe that the Hull Public Schools have the primary responsibility for the formal education of the children and youth of the community. However, the School Committee recognizes that many governmental agencies and community organizations, while not primarily concerned with education, play a definite role in education.

Therefore, it will be the desire of the Committee to establish positive working relationships with all other public and private organizations that contribute to the education process and to the general welfare of the citizens of the community.

Proposed plans, projects, or activities of community organizations must be evaluated and promoted in light of their stated contribution to the academic as well as the athletic and fine arts programs of the schools. Care must be taken to avoid compromising or diluting the responsibilities and authorities of the School Committee.
