
### Advanced Placement (AP) Exams Overview

- In order to label a class "AP", syllabi must be submitted and approved by The College Board
- Many colleges waive classes for students who earn a 3 or better on an AP exam
- These are college-level courses
- The highest possible score = 5




### Number of Students Taking AP Exams (2010 – 2014)




## Hull High School Number of Students (2010 – 2014)




## Percentage of Students Taking at least one AP Exam (2010 – 2014)




### Number of AP Exams Taken (2010 – 2014)

### Percentage of Students Earning a 3 or Better (2009 – 2014)




#### AP Trends

- The number of students taking at least one AP course decreased last year but has increased this year.
- The average scores went up slightly in US History and Calculus – two areas of focus.
- The Biology and APES scores are still very strong.
- The English scores are hovering.
- In order to raise scores, 5 teachers have received College Board training in the past few years.


### Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) Overview

- Nationally normed and standardized test
- Tests student's basic knowledge and skill a=in the areas of reading, mathematics and writing
- Evaluates how a student thinks, reasons and communicates
- SAT scores are still an essential part of the admissions process
- Maximum possible score: 2400 (800 each in critical reading, mathematics and writing)

- We believed that last years decline in scores was an aberration and we were correct.
- Our goal is to have HHS students score at or above the Massachusetts state average and we are close.
- To increase scores:

  - All English teachers are using SAT vocabulary books, and;
  - We will be offering free on-line SAT prep courses to all students
