## Youth Opioid Prevention Grant

Enhance current curriculum by incorporating Social Emotional Learning principles Selfawareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, responsible decision making) in grades 4 – 8 through implementation of the top-rated substance abuse prevention program, Botvin LifeSkills Training.

- 1. Teach students the necessary skills to resist social (peer) pressures to smoke, drink, and use drugs.
- 2. Help students to develop greater self-esteem and self-confidence.
- 3. Enable students to effectively cope with anxiety.
- 4. Increase their knowledge of the immediate consequences of substance abuse.
- 5. Enhance cognitive and behavioral competency to reduce and prevent a variety of health risk behaviors.

## Grant Activities

In order to accomplish the implementation of the program in 5 grades during the two year grant period, a mental health consultant (social worker, health educator, or counselor) will be hired (300 hours at \$50.00 an hour over 2 years) to work with the adjustment counselors at the middle school and elementary school to implement the program.

After the two year period, the program will be implemented in grades 4 and in grades 6 - 8.

Lifeskills Curriculum Materials (\$5,000) purchased through grant.

Parent training course will be offered to middle school parents during the first year and going forward the parent training will be offered to grade 6 parents.

HPS partnered with Manet and Hull Alliance for the Prevention of Substance Addiction (HASPA) to assist with the parent trainings.
