

Permit Fees and Definitions adopted January 6, 2006

- 1) **CAP OFF. \$60.00**
valid for 60 days from date of issuance
sewer installer pulls permit
Disconnection of an existing building sewer from the town system and capping the end connected to the town system.
- 2) **REPAIR. \$125.00**
valid for 60 days from date of issuance
sewer installer pulls permit
Repair to damaged pipe as part of an existing sewer connection.
- 3) **NEW CONNECTION. \$200.00**
valid for 6 months from date of issuance
sewer installer pulls permit
Installation of a new building sewer to serve a new structure.
- 4) **RE-DIRECT CONNECTION. \$200.00**
valid for 6 months from date of issuance
sewer installer pulls permit
Replacing an existing building sewer in the existing location or in a new location.
- 5) **GRINDER PUMP SYSTEM. \$300.00**
valid for 60 days from date of issuance
sewer installer pulls permit
Installation of a grinder or sewerage ejector pump system including force mains, gravity lines, and connection to the town system.
- 6) **RECONNECTION OF CAP OFF. \$60.00**
valid for 60 days from date of issuance
Sewer installer pulls permit
Reconnection of a building sewer to the town system where work is not included as part of a New Connection or Redirect Connection.
7. **LOW PRESSURE GRINDER PUMP SYSTEM.**
OWNER PAYS FEE & PULLS PERMIT
\$1000.00 2 checks \$100.00 & \$900.00
valid for 1 year from date of issuance
Installation of a low-pressure grinder pump connected to the Town of Hull low-pressure sewer system. Permit fees and low-pressure sewer requirements are contained in the Hull Sewer Commission Low Pressure Sewer Connection Review and Installation Requirements Policy, adopted March 18th 2004.
