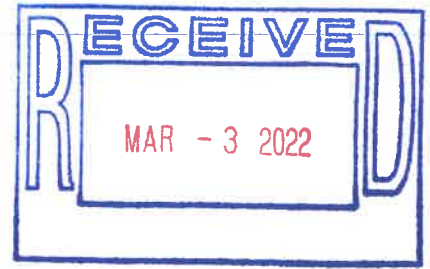


Beach Grass Planting North Nantasket Beach

March 26, 9:00am to 12:00pm



The Beach Management Committee, in coordination with the Town of Hull Conservation Department and Department of Public Works, will be holding the annual Town of Hull **Beach Grass Planting Event on Saturday, March 26th 9am - 12pm** with a *rain date* of Sunday, March 27th. We will be planting beach grass from Phipps St. north in areas designated by the Conservation Administrator to be badly in need of beach grass. To volunteer to plant, please sign up by sending an email to beachgrassplanting@gmail.com and please include the number of people who will be planting with you. If the day for Beach Grass Planting must be moved to March 27 due to weather, we will notify you directly by email. Beach grass and tools will be available for pick up on March 26th at 9am at the A Street Beach Entrance. Please bring a large pail to transport your beach grass to the beach.

The Beach Management Committee has made beach grass planting an annual community event to maintain the dune so it can continue to absorb the brunt of winter storms. The dune is critical to the protection of the Town from flooding and storm damage.

For those who may not be able to attend the Town-wide event on March 26th, individuals may pick up beach grass for planting at the DPW, located at 9 Nantasket Ave, starting on March 18th and continuing to March 31st or until all the beach grass is gone. Planting on the dune is not permitted after March 31st due to Piping Plover nesting season beginning April 1st. Please bring a large pail to transport your beach grass. Tools will not be available for the beach grass picked up at DPW, but a large screwdriver, broom stick, or a crowbar can serve as effective planting tools.
