

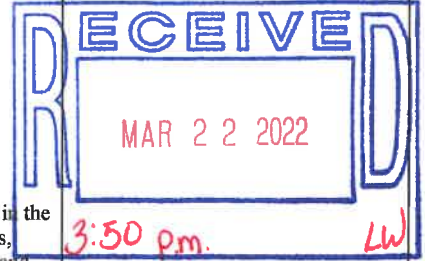


MEETING NOTICE POSTING & AGENDA

Citizen's Petition

Purpose:

To create a diverse and inclusive committee of Hull Citizens to investigate the specific needs and space requirement for a new Senior Center for the Town of Hull. This committee to be known as the "Hull Senior Center Committee" will be charged with identifying the projected cost of creating this Senior Center either in an existing space or in a newly created space.

Proposed Article:

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from **Free Cash**, \$20,000 to authorize and fund the creation of a "Hull Senior Center Committee" with a budget not to exceed \$20,000 for administrative support. The committee will be chaired by the Co- Chair of the Hull Council on Aging (COA) and will include the following membership:

- A representative of each voting precinct in Hull, selected by the Co-Chair of the COA from individuals who have submitted a letter of interest. (3)
- Two representatives from Hull High School, selected by the Co-Chair of the COA from individuals who have submitted a letter of interest. (2)
- Two members of the COA elected by the COA. (2)
- A member of each of the following town board, elected by the respective boards; (3)
 - Select Board, School Committee, Planning Board, Hull Redevelopment Authority
- The Director of the Hull Senior Center (1)
- The Co-Chair of the COA (1)

This 12 member committee will identify the needs of a new Senior Center and identify projected costs and funding opportunities for the creation of such a Center. This committee will be expected to submit monthly updates to the community via the Town of Hull website and via The Hull Times and to present an update of findings at the 2023 Hull Town Meeting.
