Dear Hull Village Property Owner:

An application for Certificate of Appropriateness has been received by the Hull Historic District Commission for work on the above described property which abuts your property according to HDC standards as well as of concern to other property owners in the district. The proposed work includes:

- Rebuild existing 2 level deck, posts, beams, rails and stairs
- Replace / add support posts/footings with trim on front porch area
- Replace all windows and associated trim
- Restore siding and trim
- Misc. repairs

In accordance with the Hull Historic District Bylaw and Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40C, the Commission will hold a public hearing on an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness if the Commission determines that the proposed alteration to the exterior features, new construction or demolition is substantial in its effect on the overall Historic District.
