Application for Endorsement of Plan believed not to require approval: 17 Glover Avenue

The Planning Board of the Town of Hull, Massachusetts, will hold a Public Hearing on WEDNESDAY, January 10th, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. at HULL MEMORIAL MIDDLE SCHOOL, 81 Central Avenue Hull, Massachusetts. This hearing will be on the petition of The Propocio Companies, 33 Village Road, Middleton, MA, to approve a Nantasket Beach Overlay District Special Permit for land located at 0 George Washington Boulevard and 189 and 193 Nantasket Avenue (Assessors Map 37, Lot 002,003,004). The applicant is proposing a three story mixed use building with 132 residential units totaling 188,511 Sq Ft, with 6,971 Sq Ft of commercial space on 3.4 acres of land.
