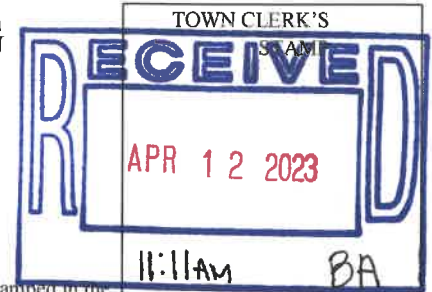




# MEETING NOTICE POSTING & AGENDA
