DCR Recreational Advisory: Nantasket Beach in Hull

WHAT: Beginning Friday, August 14, 2020 until further notice, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), in coordination with the Town of Hull, will reduce total parking capacity at agency-managed parking areas at Nantasket Beach State Reservation in the Town of Hull by 50 percent.

Additionally, when visiting state beaches, pools, parks, and other properties, DCR reminds the public to adhere to the following guidance:

- If a location is crowded, please consider leaving the area and either visiting a different location or returning at a later date or time;
- Follow posted rules and posted parking restrictions;
- Stay within solitary or small groups;
- Practice social distancing of at least six feet between individuals;
- Wear a facial mask or covering in public when not swimming;
- Practice healthy personal hygiene, such as handwashing for at least 20 seconds; and,
- Stay home if ill, over 70, and/or part of a vulnerable population.
