SEWER INVESTIGATIONS WORK NOTICE

March 2020

WHAT: Town-wide Sanitary Sewer Evaluation Survey. This work consists of sanitary sewer inspections to obtain flow measurements during nighttime hours.

WHERE: Town-wide.

WHEN: Starting on March 10th. The work is weather dependent. Night-time work is scheduled between March 10 and March 27. Night-time work between midnight and 6:00 am consists of opening sewer manholes to take flow measurements.

WHY: To obtain flow measurements when most people are not using the sewer to isolate areas where groundwater is leaking into the sewer system.

WHO: Flow Assessment Services (Contractor), BMC (Contractor), and Woodard & Curran (W&C, Engineer)

Impact on Area: Expect minor/local traffic detours/delays. Any noise should be minimal.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: Why is the Town completing this Project?

A: The Town's infrastructure is aging, and the sewer system is critical to public health and safety. The sewer system collects wastewater for our residents and businesses. Keeping this infrastructure in good working condition is critical to our quality of life. The Town systematically evaluates the sewer system to inform capital planning for improvements. These improvements help to maintain the sewer system and help protect our waterways and beaches.

Q: How will my property be impacted?

A: All work is performed on Town owned streets, and easements. Minimal traffic impact is expected.

Q: Is the work noisy?

A: Noises from banging on manhole covers may occur. Noise from vector trucks may occur during the daytime. Night-time noise will be minimal if at all in localized areas.

Q: Will there be any excavation, especially in areas where the road was recently paved?

A: No, unless defects in the sewer are found

Q: Will there be nighttime work? What is the schedule?

A: Night-time work between midnight and 6:00 am will occur beginning March 10 and finish March 27, weather dependent. This work includes opening sewer manhole covers to measure sewer flows.

Q: Who will be coming to the neighborhood?

A: Flow Assessment Services, BMC, and Woodard & Curran will be completing this work. All Contractors will be clearly identified by their company credentials and vehicles. The Town of Hull Police Details will be onsite assisting in traffic control and pedestrian access while work is being completed.
