

ATLANTIC AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE May 2, 2024

Previous Two Weeks Summary

In the previous two weeks, the Contractor has been working to complete the installation of granite curbing and repair curb that was damaged over the winter, as well as raising the covers for manholes to the finished roadway grades. The Contractor has also constructed additional drainage structures and pipes to facilitate a raised crosswalk at the Montana Avenue intersection.

Three Week Look Ahead

The upcoming schedule is as follows, weather permitting:

- Monday, May 6th to Friday, May 10th: remainder of manhole covers and utility covers will be raised to finished grade.
- Monday, May 13th to Friday, May 17th: pavement milling will commence for short stretches on all side streets and on Nantasket Avenue at their intersection with Atlantic Avenue.
- Monday, May 20th to Friday, May 24th: final surface course of pavement will be paved throughout the entire project.

Traffic Impacts

Through-traffic should avoid the area for the next three - four weeks when feasible. Through vehicle traffic may be detoured as necessary between School Street and Jerusalem Road during the daytime for the foreseeable future with one lane of traffic open for local traffic. Pedestrians, bicycles, school buses, and emergency vehicles will continue to be able to travel through the construction area. Access to residences, businesses and the Town Hall will also be maintained. At least one travel lane will be maintained at all times with police directing traffic as needed.

Raised manhole covers within the roadway may pose obstacles for vehicles and bicyclists. Please exercise caution traveling through Atlantic Avenue and seek alternate routes when possible. The construction may cause noise disruption during the work hours of 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
