The first person named on the petition is considered the “Petitioner,” and will be considered the sponsor of the Article. The Petitioner may be asked to appear before the Advisory Committee and other Boards and Committees to explain the purpose of the proposed Article prior to Town Meeting. In addition, the Petitioner will be designated the primary speaker in support of the Article at Town Meeting unless someone else is noted below.

The deadline for submission of Citizen’s Petitions is final - please check with the Town Clerk’s Office to confirm the date for each Town Meeting.
