

FIRE PREVENTION

Our goal is to reduce the risk of harm and injury for every citizen in the Town of Hull.

Safety Tips:

- Smoke Detectors – test monthly, change batteries twice a year (spring forward/fall back).
- Carbon Monoxide Detectors – required in every household per state law (Nicole’s Law eff. 3/31/06)
- Families must practice escape plans in case of a fire. Always have 2 ways out of a room (door/escape ladder if necessary). Stay low and go! Have a meeting spot.
- Winter – STAY OFF THE ICE. If you see someone on the ice, call 911.
- Common Inspections – smoke detector (\$50.00), oil tank removal/replace (\$50.00).
- Burning season – January 15th – May 1st. Call 781 925-8111 for free permit/instructions.
