

## **CHAPTER 104**

#### **ARTICLE I Prohibited Discard**

**S104.1. Littering prohibited**

No person, corporation, firm, business organization or entity shall throw, place, discard or cause to be thrown, placed or discarded upon any beach, street or sidewalk in the town or land owned or operated by the town, except in such areas so designated by the Board of Health and/or Board of Selectmen, any stones, hoops, boards, wood, shavings, sawdust, manure, nails, spokes, screws, bottles, glass, tin cans, metal, filth, rubbish, trash, garbage, litter, papers or refuse or other liquid or solid matter or substance.

**S104-2. Violations and penalties**

Any person violating the provisions of this Article shall be liable to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300) for each offense.

#### **ARTICLE II Use of Town Waste Barrels**

**S104-3. Household waste**

- A. No person or entity shall place or cause to be placed rubbish, waste or trash originated and/or generated from a household in or beside waste

barrels maintained by the town.

- B. This prohibition shall not apply to rubbish, waste or trash remaining after a recreational activity on a public park, playground, conservation, beach or other such public or recreational area.

**S104-4. Business or commercial waste**

No business or person acting for or on behalf of a business shall place or cause to be placed rubbish, waste or trash originated and/or generated from an industrial, commercial or business activity in waste barrels maintained by the town.

**S104-5. Violations and penalties**

Any person violating the provisions of this Article shall be liable to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300) for each offense.

**ARTICLE III  
Selectmen's Authority**

**S104-6. Delegation of authority**

The town authorizes and empowers the Selectmen to contract, regulate and supervise the disposal of rubbish, garbage and waste materials in accordance with MGL C40, s4.
