NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS

S129-1. Compliance required; time limit.

Street numbers shall be provided for each dwelling and each business, industrial and other building in the town by the owner of such structures by ninety (90) days after approval by the Attorney General, in accordance with this chapter.

S129-2. Materials and placement.

- A. The numbers shall be made of permanent weatherproof material, shall be at least three (3) inches in height and shall be clearly visible from the street or roadway upon which the dwelling or building fronts.
- B. The numbers shall be placed on each structure or on a suitable support near he main entrance to the structure so as to be visible.
- 3. The numbers shall be those assigned to each structure in accordance with the street numbers issued by the Board of Assessors.

S129-3. New buildings.

The owner of any property seeking a building permit for a new building or structure shall apply for an receive a building number designation from the Board of Assessors or its designee prior to submitting application to the Building Official for a permit, and no building permit shall be issued without designation of such building number.

S129-4. Responsibility of owner.

It shall be the responsibility of each property owner in the town to obtain a number assigned to his affected structure or structures within three (3) months of the effective date of this

chapter.

S129-5. Violations and penalties.

Failure to comply with this chapter shall subject the offending property owner(s) to a fine not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.). Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
