

ATLANTIC AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE March 14, 2024

Construction resuming Monday, March 18th

The Atlantic Avenue Project, funded under the MassDOT Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), will resume construction on Monday, March 18th.

Over the winter period, the utility companies completed the relocation of the utility poles consistent with the new roadway layout. The Contractor, P.A. Landers, will resume their work next week by raising the covers for manholes to the final roadway grades. This is anticipated to take 2-3 weeks to complete and will be conducted throughout the entire stretch of Atlantic Avenue. In addition, the Contractor will begin work to install new drainage structures and pipes at the intersection with Montana Avenue.

The other remaining work to be carried out over the next several months includes:

- Installation of granite curbing at various locations throughout the project.
- Completion of sidewalk paving
- Pavement milling, mostly on side streets at the limits of work
- Paving the final surface course of pavement throughout the project.
- Installing new pavement markings and signage

The project is anticipated to be substantially completed by the beginning of July.

Traffic Impacts

Through vehicle traffic may be detoured as necessary between School Street and Jerusalem Road during the daytime for the foreseeable future with one lane of traffic open for local traffic. Pedestrians, bicycles, school buses, and emergency vehicles will continue to be able to travel through the construction area. Access to residences, businesses and the Town Hall will also be maintained. At least one travel lane will be maintained at all times with police directing traffic as needed.

Please exercise caution traveling through Atlantic Avenue and seek alternate routes when possible. The construction may cause noise disruption during the work hours of 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
